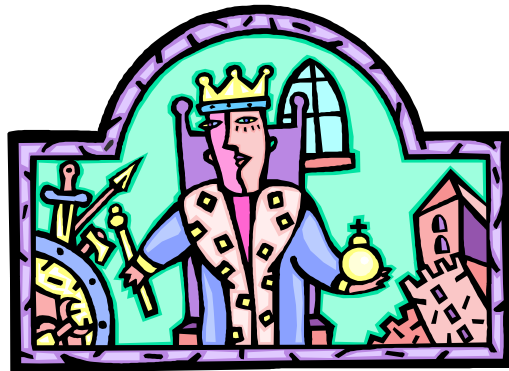

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Mistress Kiri and THLord Muirghen for stepping up as deputies to the MOAS office. It’s rare that you get one deputy, much less two and I know they will bring a wealth of experience to the office.

The Fall University is scheduled for October 1, 2005 and will be held in the Stronghold of Raven’s Cove (Jacksonville, N.C.). For those who have not attended University before, it is a great opportunity to “sample” particular topics and art forms without a heavy expense of time and money. There are knowledgeable instructors to guide you through the process & minimize frustrations. Most classes are low-cost or no cost, allowing you to “try out” a project without commitment. If I might make a suggestion for those attending University for the first time: take one class on a topic you love, and one class on a topic you know nothing about and one class that adds to your ability to participate in the SCA in general. This method promotes growth in all facets of your artistic development and ensures you have something to share with the rest of the Barony.

This month, we will be holding the preliminary meeting for folks interested in creating an A&S Entry, start to finish for KASF. Even if you are not planning on entering KASF, the skills gained in this exercise will benefit you in any A&S display or competition. At the first meeting, we will be starting on picking a project and finding a period example to use as our inspiration. (This will begin the documentation process). The next step (in October, meeting TBD by Sept. attendees) will cover materials: what was used in your “inspiration piece” and where can you get some. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or would like to participate in the project.
