Tarot Games (Adriana Michaels)**

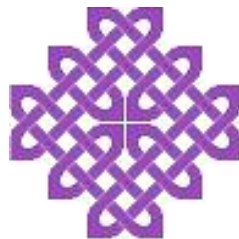
This class will cover the rules for one card game played with tarot cards, as well as the history of tarot games. Afterwards, there will be plenty of time to play the game itself.

October Baronial Business Meeting

October 4, 2005

Before the meeting started, Bozhana passed out a questionnaire. It contained two common questions: "How long have you been in the SCA?" and "Do you participate in combat (heavy, rapier, archery, thrown weapons, etc.);" Other questions varied from survey to survey. They were:

- What do you expect from a knight?
- What do you expect as a person in Dun Carraig?
- How does Dun Carraig meet the needs for a newcomer? For someone who's been in longer than 6 yrs?
- What do you enjoy most about Dun Carraig?
- What do fighters add to the barony?
- Why am I in the SCA?
- What do you expect from a peer?

The answers were read anonymously by Theron, who, as a marshal, is used to reading people's chicken-scratch. This activity was sort of an ice-breaker, helping members of the Barony see how their fellow members felt about these topics.

Old Business:

Challenge of the Heart:

- There have been problems with selecting a date for Challenge of the Heart. Due to weather, we cannot hold the event any earlier than April. Also, the site will not allow us to hold the event during camp season, which begins after Memorial Day, and May has been eliminated due to other event conflicts, as well as Mother's Day weekend.
- In previous years, we have had an April Challenge.
- The two possible dates are the last two weekends in April, with the 22nd as the first pick.
- Holding the event the last weekend in April would mean conflicting with the Celtic festival.
- It was pointed out that the group lost money on the event last time it conflicted with the Celtic festival, but it was also mentioned that Challenge has become a bigger draw than it has been in the past.
- The possibility of moving the event to the fall was discussed, but there was a concern that this might conflict with other fall events.
- More camping is expected for this year than in previous years, since

many day-trippers got to see how nice the site is.

- Theron made a motion to hold the event the 4th weekend in April, but there was no vote as Gallileo will need to check on site availability first.

Blessing of the Fleet:

- The Blessing of the Fleet demo on Saturday, October first was a tremendous success.
- Muirghen thanked everyone for making this “the best demo ever.” A special thanks goes to those who fought all day, getting the attention and interest of many people.
- Another special thanks goes to Lord Tarfinn, who fought both rapier and heavy.
- The group also thanked Muirghen for the hard work that he put into organizing this very successful demo.
- Dun Carraig has never had a demo that actually brought in money...until now. A donation of \$100 was given to the group to pay for food for the day, and there was \$27 left over, which will be deposited into the barony’s account.
- It was pointed out that, since many people expressed an interest in fight practice, barony members need to make sure to attend if possible, so that new people aren’t showing up to an empty hall.
- It was also mentioned that it’s important for everyone to talk to new people and make them feel welcome.



New Business:

The Seadogs E-mail List:

- A new announcement board has been created, for the purpose of posting classes, meetings, and other “read-only” info, which will allow people to stay informed about things going on in the barony.
- Officers will have posting privileges on this list, but anyone is welcome to submit information to Bozhana to have it posted on the list. This is intended to keep the list as announcements only, while keeping the discussion on the Seadogs list.
- In addition to class, practice, and meeting schedules, this list can also be used to post things like museum events and displays, Master Tristan’s scribal day in December, etc.—any read-only information.
- Information posted to the announcements list will automatically be

posted to the Seadogs list.

- The idea of moderation of the list was discussed. Some suggested that this might be a moot point, as there is now an announcement list for those who don't want to be a part of the discussion list.
- Concerns related to list moderation included:
 - Hurt feelings from negative comments on the list.
 - The possibility of scaring off new members with heated discussion.
 - How moderation would be handled and by whom.
 - What penalties would be enforced and what would be the standard of acceptability.
 - Ensuring that group members are allowed to speak their minds and have their voices heard.
 - If people leave the list due to heated discussion (which the announcement board makes more feasible), they would miss the discussion of issues which often precedes a vote.
- After discussion, the issue was put to a vote, and it was decided that the list would not be moderated.
- Another issue regarding the list is the problem of lost posts. Jonathas explained that the ISP has recently set a limit on the number of messages any one domain may send out in an hour or in a minute. Once this limit is reached, messages are not sent. Because the mailing list has over fifty members, every post to the list is counted as fifty separate e-mails. Posts made by people with Dun Carraig e-mail accounts also count toward this limit.
- The ISP will not tell us what the limit is.
- Because of these problems, the barony will be moving to a new ISP as soon as possible.
- Also discussed was the need to clarify who should be a part of the Seadogs list.
- Currently, the charter states that "members" of Dun Carraig may belong to the list. If the group would like to change this definition, for example, to include those who play with the group but technically reside within the borders of other groups, this would require a change to the charter.

Baronial Birthday:

- Baronial birthday will be held at Molly and Erwin's and house on October 22nd. People can start arriving at 10:00 AM.
- Bring your own meat and a side to share, and please post to the list or tell Bozhana what you'll be bringing. Otherwise, we might have forty gallons of potato salad and nothing else!

- Please also let Bozhana know if you'll be attending.
- Parking is a major issue. Matthias, Phillip, and Theron have offered to shuttle people to the house, so please park further away, allowing visitors from other baronies to park close to the house.
- Those in charge of fighting (rapier, heavy, etc.) should bring whatever materials they need, or delegate that to others. Any required set-up can be done either Friday night or Saturday morning.
- Volunteers are needed for this event.

12th Night:

- Jynette will e-mail those who have volunteered for various positions, as well as posting to the list what positions are left to be filled.
- She will also post the set-up chart to the list.
- A new kingdom law has been proposed that may affect the event and the amount of money that will go to the kingdom. Officers will provide more details on that when those details are known.

Fight Practices:

- Fight practices were discussed at the Officers' Meeting.
- Any new practices will go through Knight Marshall's office. Certain criteria must be followed, and the Seneschal has to approve any practice.
- The Sunday practice in Waldorf went well, but may be hard to maintain. We're currently using the facility under "gentleman's agreement," not a written one. A written agreement would help with liability, to keep us from being responsible for non-Dun Carraig people.
- The Indian Head rapier practice, which takes place on Monday nights, was discussed. This is not the official Dun Carraig rapier practice, so cannot be publicized in newsletter as such. However, those who wish to attend the practice can contact Alienor for details.
- The practice can also be posted on the announcement list, the Merry Rose, and other forums.
- Anyone who has other ideas of practices or wants to gather people to practice can post to the list. There must be a martial present to hold a practice, and unofficial practices should not conflict with established ones.

Inventory of Armor & Weapons:

- We have 1 full set of loaner rapier gear w/ weapons and one "almost" full set.
- For heavy fighting, every piece of loaner armor has been donated. One weapon (still not put together) is also part of our loaner gear.

- The difference between the two classes of rapier blade was also explained for the benefit of non-fencers. There are light (“epee”) and heavy (sometimes referred to as “schlager”), each of which have separate authorizations. Initial practice and training is done with light rapier blades. Heavy is an advanced form, so there probably does not need to be a loaner schlager.
- The group voted to purchase a new light rapier blade, at a cost of about \$30.

List fence:

- The list fence was broken, and needs to be repaired. The lumber needed would cost less than \$100. However, Theron and Muirghen both have boards that can be used toward repairing the fence. The issue was tabled until it can be determined whether those boards will be enough to fix the fence or we will need to purchase more.

School demo:

- Rose was asked for a demo by a teacher at Mill Creek Middle School, which is in Lusby, near fight practice.
- Sixty to one-hundred seventh graders will be present.
- The demo could take place on the 21st or the 28th.
- It was decided to hold the demo on the 21st, since that would allow more people to attend than the other date.

Quartermaster:

- The group needs a new officer, a quartermaster. This person will be responsible for getting an inventory of items belonging to the barony.
- After the initial count, this will be done quarterly and after each event.
- The quartermaster will need to travel to the homes of the various people who are storing baronial gear.
- This is not a depreciation checklist, just an inventory for our own use.
- Jim volunteered to be the group’s Quartermaster.

MoM:

The group still needs a Mistress (or Minister) of Minors.

Resolution Meeting:

- It was discussed that people have felt that their voices were not heard, so a meeting at which all concerns could be discussed was proposed.
- The date will be Sunday after Storvik’s Birthday (the 16th), early in the afternoon.

- A vote was taken and this meeting was approved, with eight members voting “no” and the rest voting in favor of the meeting.
- Because of the timing, the meeting may need to be held at someone’s house rather than at a neutral site.



Officer Reports:

Exchequer—

- The current account balance is \$1976.14
- As soon as the September bank statement is in, Kaolin will teach Serena how to do quarterly reports, then pass the final book.
- Serena’s warrant has been completed and will be turned in at Crusades.
- The review of books with Regional and Exchequer in Charge of Review will also be done at Crusades.
- Please help Serena out as she takes on this very important job.
- Kaolin is also working on a new signature card.

Chatelaine—

- Rose is not yet the official chatelaine, .since her warrant does not appear on the website.
- See the discussion list (and the earlier mention in the minutes) for details on the Mill Creek Middle School Demo.

Chronicler—

Lylie is now working on Tuesday evenings. Adriana will take meeting notes and put together the newsletter until Lylie can get her schedule changed.

Herald—

Submissions presented at Pennsic are being forwarded. To date I am aware of passes by Kingdom for Minna Rose von Kroppe (Name and Device) and Matthew of Summerdale (Name), a redraw for Mistress Minowara Kiritsubo, Sensei for augmentation of device and a discussion of Heraldic title for same, and a bounce for device for Kaolin inn Oargi. I know there are more since there were better than 8 submissions. Since I did not see a letter of Intent (LOI) for this, I am requesting that as you are notified, please let me know the status you receive from Golden Dolphin.

I have been Dun Carraig Baronial Herald for over 6 years now, far exceeding any reasonable term and am looking to pass my office. I have secured a pledge for mentoring from Mistress Kiri (a former Triton Herald) and of course I will also provide what aid I can. I am looking to step down in the next few months, but no later than 12th Night. Again, it is my intent to retain my warrant as a herald, just pass off the Baronial Herald duties.

A&S—

- KASF nights will continue, not on A&S night. The next meeting will focus on the materials used for each person's project.
- Also, a new guild is being formed in the barony, the Divination Guild, founded by Minna.
- The Middle Eastern costuming class, taught by Mary Isabelle, will take place on Tuesday the 10th, Adriana will be teaching a class on tarot games on November 8, and an astrology class will be taught by Minna on November 22nd,

Chiurgeon—

- Minna is still working on the paperwork involved in becoming a chirurgeon.
- Matt is Minna's new deputy.
- Minna has been in touch with the Kingdom chirurgeon and has a mentor for her and Matt, who will help them through the process of becoming chirurgeons.

MoL—

- No event, no report.

Web Minister—

- If you can help with the website, please talk to James.

Seneschal—

- Therewasanear -unanimousvoteforBozhanatostayonasseneschal. Shepointedouthatshedidnotwanttoleavetheposition,butwantedtomakesurethatthebaronywasinsupportofkeepingherasthe seneschal.
- Bozhanawouldlikefeedbackonthequestionsandseatingarrangement attonight'smeeting.

Knight Marshal—

- If you fight, please look at becoming a marshal. There will be a marshal's program at University.
- The Knight Marshal is in charge of all combat activities, rapier, etc. All marshals are deputies to the Knight Marshal.
- Please attend fight practice!
- There will be archery practice on Thursday at Jonathas's house
- There currently is no thrown weapons happening in the barony. Please let Hank know if you want to throw things.

- Next Sunday, the 16th, would be the Waldorf practice/demo. However, this will be cancelled due to the meeting that will be occurring instead.
- Rapier Marshal: Rapier is alive and well. I have noticed that we are particularly rough on equipment and need to make sure that swords and armour are properly inspected and checked throughout the fighting. Keep a spare blade handy, since, once bent severely, these blades generally do not recover and pose a potential danger.

- Rules changes/interpretations:
 - 3.5.5 Rapier Combat Weapons and Armor Standards Atlantia will follow Corporate Rules for Rapier in the Society for Creative Anachronism, Incorporated (found at the Society Marshals Web Site at <<http://www.sca.org/officers/marshal/combat/rapier/index.html>>) with the following exceptions:
 - 3.5.5.1 No fiberglass blades allowed
 - 3.5.5.2 No tip cuts or push cuts allowed.

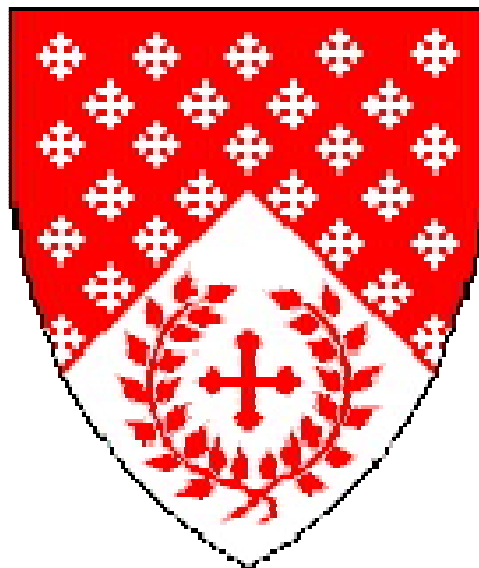
- Naming conventions: Light rapier is considered to be foil or epee (in all its forms, including double wide); heavy rapier is considered to be schlager in all its forms, including manufacturers names such as deltin, alchem etc. Note there is a contradiction between the Kingdom Earl Marshal for Rapier's comments and the published allowed conventions with regard to rattan daggers. As of the moment, the published are the allowed, and rattan daggers are not permitted. This may change and may only have been an oversight.

- If you intend to play inter-Kingdom, East and Atlantia are in complete accord with each other; however, neither Middle, nor Meridies allow epee at THEIR events (practice and out-Kingdom they will use epee, but if you are attending an event and wish to fight rapier, be prepared to fight heavy rapier.)

B&B—

- Most of what they have to say will be discussed on the 16th and sent to the

- list. Those who don't want to attend this meeting, please still talk with the B&B.
- Jonathas and Amalia are still meeting with people in the barony, but it's going slower than they'd like. These discussions can also be held over e-mail if needed.
 - Barony members are encouraged to make their opinions known, especially at meetings. It was noted that there were three non-unanimous votes at the meeting tonight, which is more than there have been in the past 6 years.
 - Since the Barony is a democracy, everyone's vote counts.
 - Kingdom Crusades is this coming weekend. The B&B will be there with the day shade & food. Please feel free to bring food to share with the group.
