**Old Business:**

Heard nothing new on financial policy.

Uttermost West (=UW) - Adriana: Contract signed, date is on church's calendar. Updated flyer on spike. 2 classes arranged so far: 13th century Spanish clothing, autocrat's class on ADA. Almost done with first banner, looks real good. Next painting date Saturday 12/14, noon-5, at Elizabeth's.

Storage unit - Ysane: more or less picked out what we want. Will be at Jonathas & Amalia's (James & Heather's); need written agreement. Will present package to barony. Need to decide what to do with the old shed - recycle, dump, sell; may involve some expense. Discussion favored recycling at scrap metal shop.

Crown Nov 2014 bid - Kingdom calendar has Marinus, so our bid probably rejected. Kingdom would like Spring Crown 2015 in Northern region, so we could try again with Melwood (which had a conflict with the Fall 2014 date). *Note from later in the month: the calendar posting was a mistake, as a decision had not been made yet. However, we did lose the bid when the decision was made because of the high site cost at Camp St. Charles; that site might be good for a Spring Coronation. More details likely in the next newsletter.*

- 1) Registry balance \$7807.52, including \$5 just recieved from War of Wings for volunteer points.
- 2) Baronial Financial Committee
  - a. Met at fighter practice Wed. 11/13/2013 to approve budget for Fall Crown bid
  - b. Budget of approx. \$3900 (plus minor adjustment for feast comps) approved & submitted to Kingdom
  - c. Awaiting reply from Kingdom
  - d. Many thanks to all for coming out in bad weather that night after a long day at work!
- 3) Storage
  - a. Need to determine what to do with the old shed (discussed under New Business above)
  - b. New shed budgeted for around \$2000.
  - c. Location (discussed above)
  - d. Will be depreciated on a seven year schedule per Local Branch handbook.
  - e. Prefab building on a member's property the preferred solution at this point.
  - f. Still looking for new Quartermaster.
4. Inventory
  - a. Inventory needs to be done before the move, or as part of the move.
  - b. January 2014 is the best time (after Christmas, before Gulf wars), weather permitting

- c. Periodic inventory is necessary and hasn't been done in an undetermined length of time
- d. Inventory will also help us decide whether to insure shed and contents, and if so for how much. Currently, we might have a specific insurance rider on Molly&Irwin's home insurance.
- 5. Financial policy (no action from Kingdom yet)
- 6. Still looking for a deputy. Less than a year left, will not renew. Would like a new person & would like time to train them.
- 7. Receipts: Recommend that you scan them at home, in case originals get lost.

Fig. 39.—MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS OF THE ELEVENTH CENTURY.

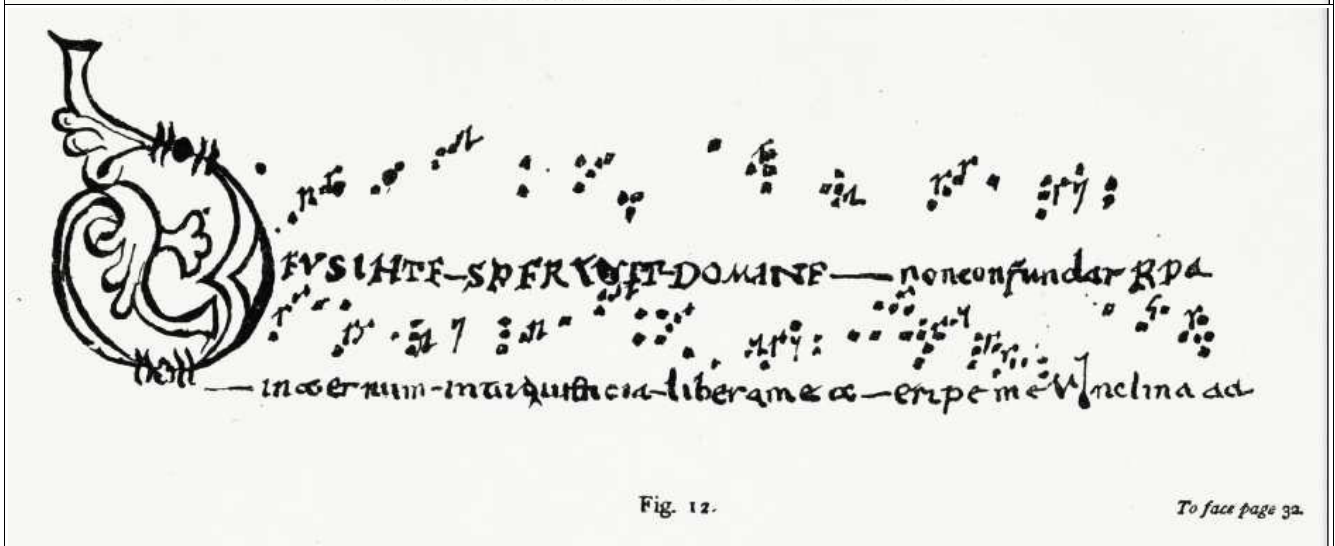
