Old Business

Royal Archery - Same as last month's business.

Chirurgion's Report

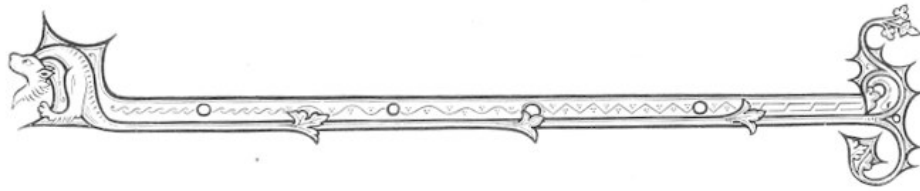
No report.

Circulated event report. Event profit \$558.34, attendance 82 adults & some kids. Bank balance \$6305.16. Will be small finance committee meeting after business meeting.

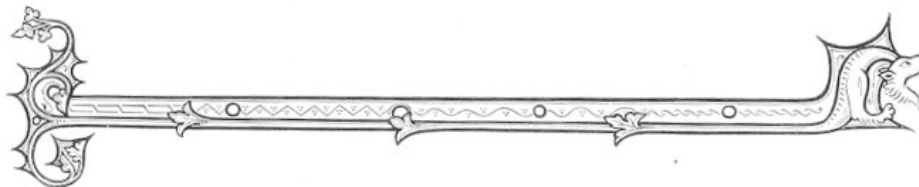
