Isolde stepping down from finance committee, looking for replacement. Can also take more alternates (Coblaith & Harald are current alternates).

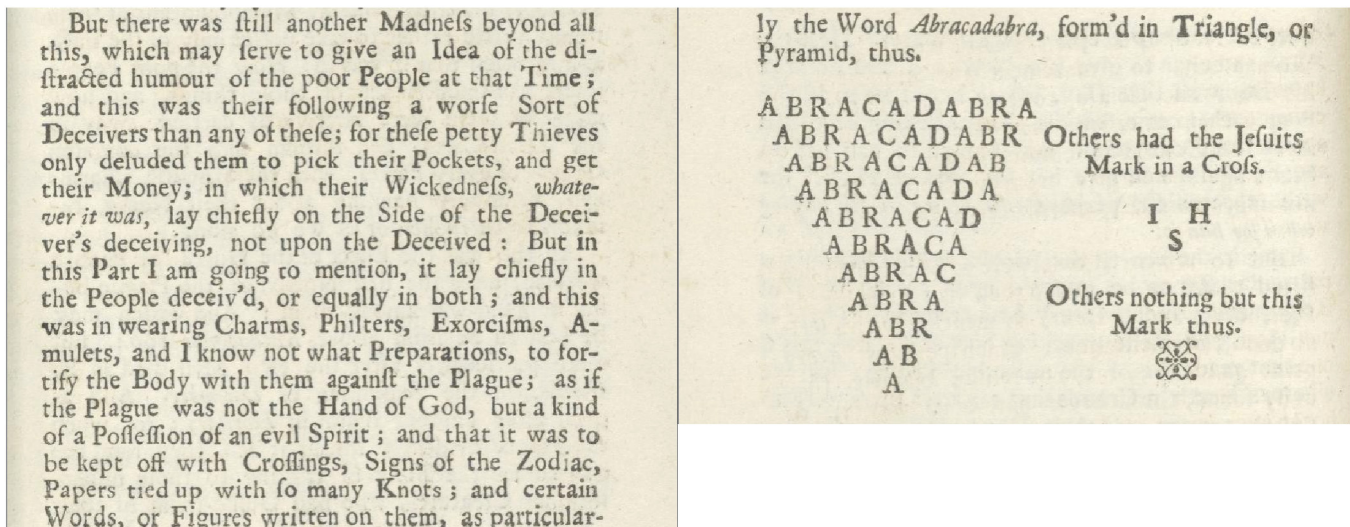
