Webminister's Report

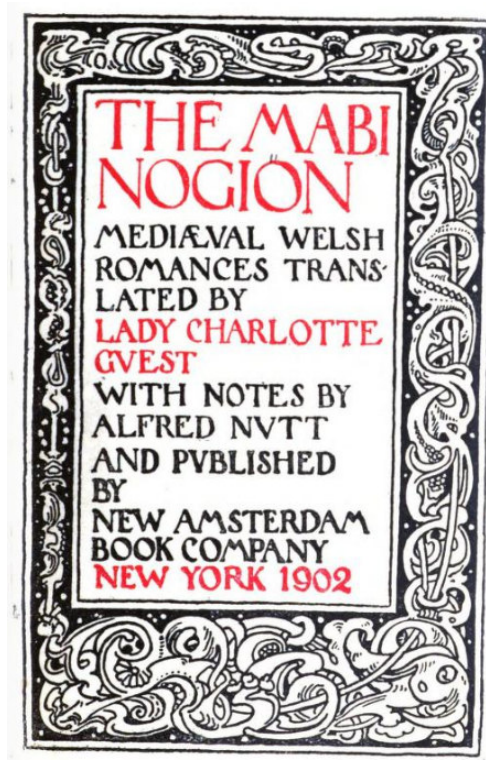
Put Valdr on Finance Committee list.

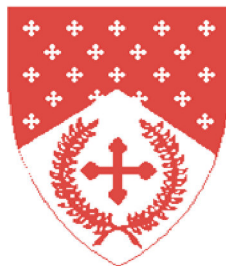

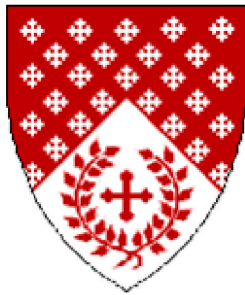
