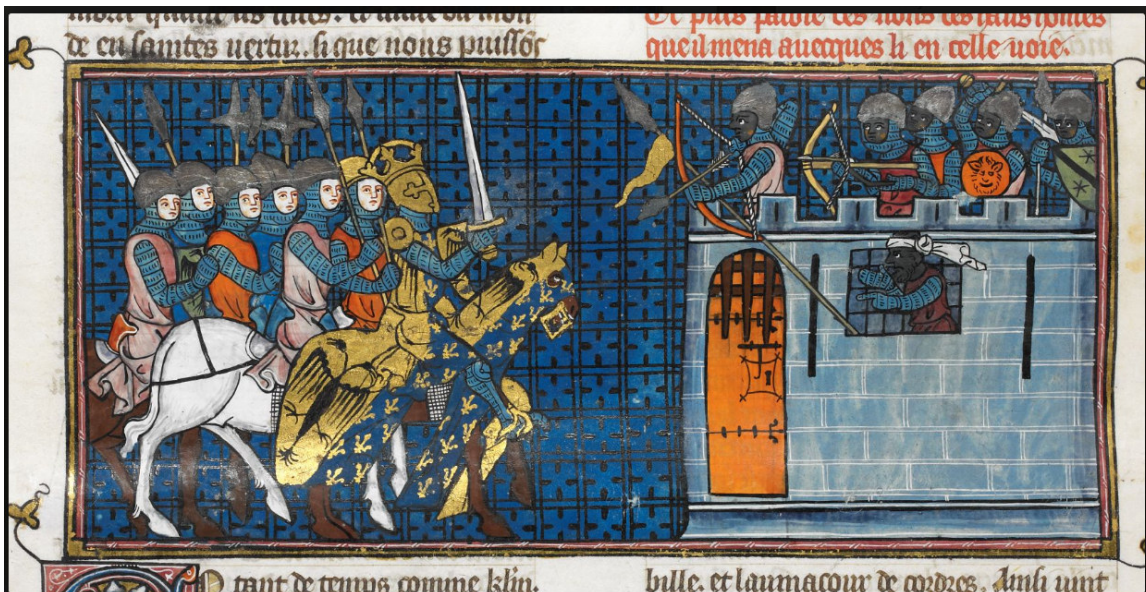
Two Swordsmen Fighting.

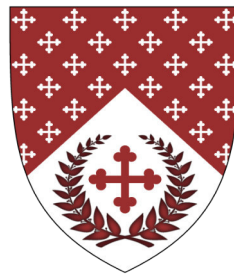

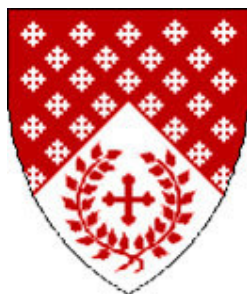
