### Exchequer's Report

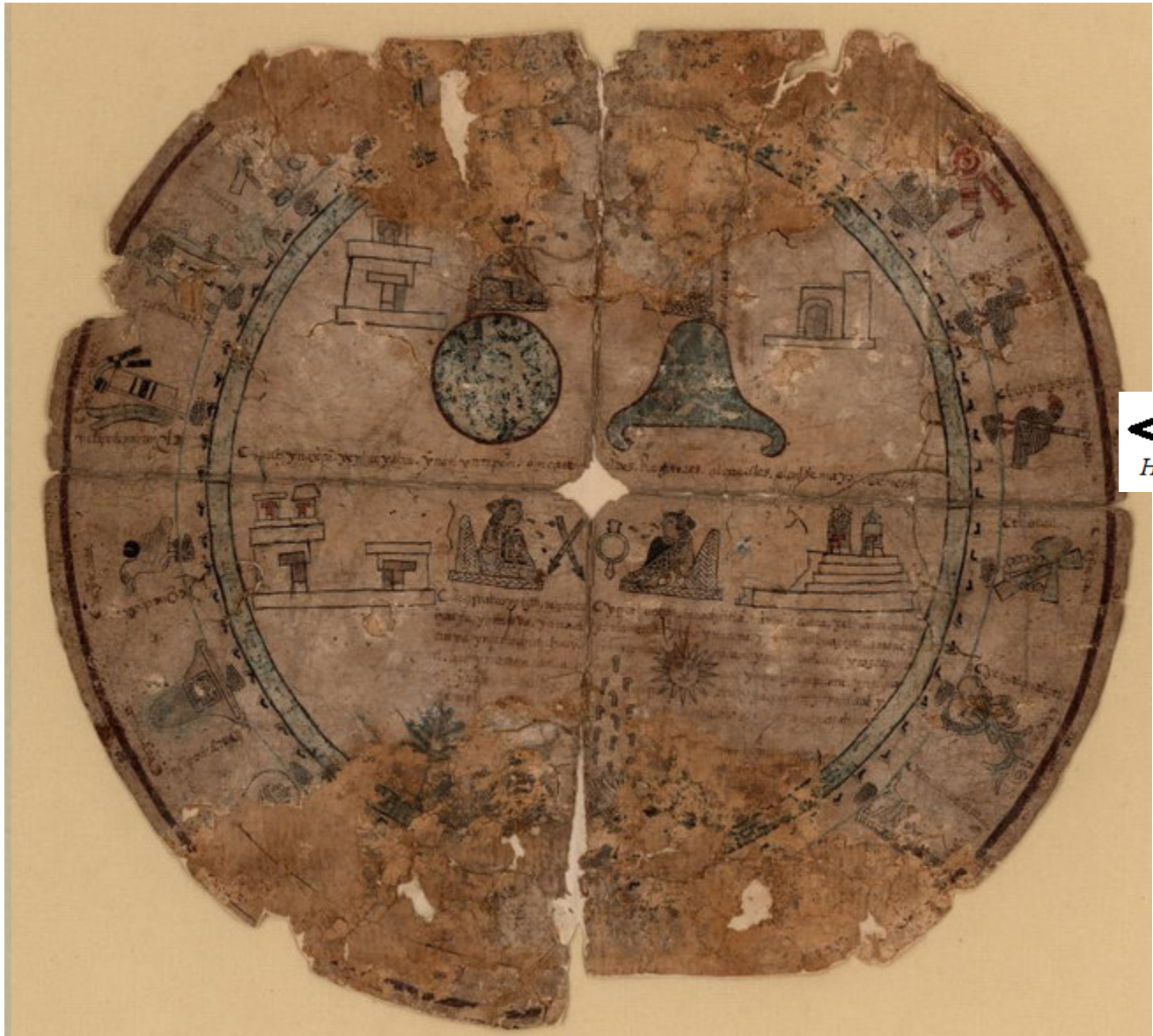

This is an Aztec calendar dating from 1530-1545, showing the 18 months of the year (with 20 days per month). The upcoming Atlantian New World Symposium, according to my reckoning, will be near the end of the month of Huey Tozoztli (marked by arrow above).

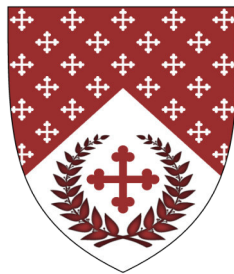

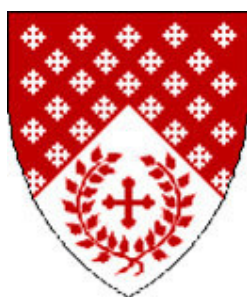
