Upcoming events

Fall event - Klaus & Ceridwen - Saturnalia Dec. 14 at Camp Merrick.

Have budget proposal, with \$20 site fee, 2 cabins @\$25, 60-person feast @\$15. Break-even if 101 people attending, (?) in cabins, 60 people in feast. Birthday 2022 had 65 people attending, Investiture 2023 had 159 people attending. Worst-case scenario (if nobody shows): \$3,505 expenses for site & feast. Financial committee voted to approve budget.

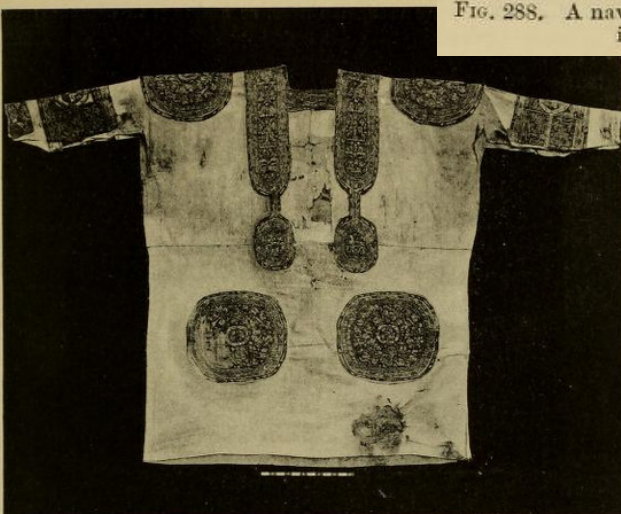


FIG. 365. Linen tunic with applied tapestry, about the sixth century, from a Coptic cemetery in Egypt. (Victoria and Albert Museum.)

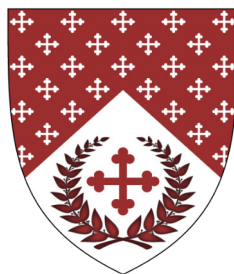

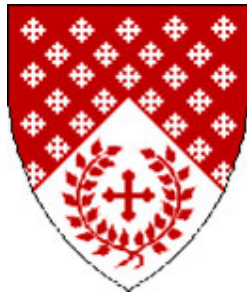
