**Upcoming events**

Seadogs Warcraft 7/13 at Good Samaritan church, in conjunction with scheduled A&S day. Activities start at 10. Last chance fighting authorizations, sewing, and garb swap/donation/yard sale. There will be potluck food 4-ish, Galen will run a grill. Minimize mess. There will be a free-will donation bucket for the church. Marguerite will be MIC & rapier (marshal?). Baronage will hold baronial court. Open positions: gate, cool water (especially out fighting), MOL & heavy marshal. Ceridwen is willing, but ask Lore first. Rose can do MOL or gate. Harald can marshal. Rose & Ceridwen can tag team on gate & MOL if Lore does not come. Yard sale - discussed free, or donate to church.

December Saturnalia - Klaus: We have some marshals, found a venue for tokens. Event is spiked. Need to alter website. Master Drew is making Roman-themed clay pottery from Calvert Cliffs, for prizes. Highnesses have been invited. Thea is making prize scrolls. BnB will choose champions at the event. May be re-introduction/inauguration of coursing, need to talk to Martine about appropriate location on site. Need thrown weapons marshal. Bookmaker has been found. Doing make-a-tunic-in-a-day contest. Encouraging themed presence from other baronies. Byzantine-themed clothing day 9/28 at church.

Solomons firehouse as event site: Rose gave a couple of dates in November 2025, they said OK on the dates. She needs to prepare info for their questions, such as safety measures. Discussed renting King's Landing (located in northern Calvert County). Can rent equestrian ring too. Can't use stoves in the kitchen.

October 13 is Southern Maryland Pride in Lexington Park, \$50 for a table, more for advertising - we could hand out fliers.

**BELISENT.** (*Vide* "Sir Otuel.")  
Daughter of Charlemagne. Married to Sir Otuel.

**FERGUS (1).** In Irish romance, a Nemedian chief who slew the Fomorian Conam.

**FERGUS (2), SIR.** A knight of King Mark, and a friend of Sir Tristram (*q.v.*). (*Vide* "Morte d'Arthur.")

**ROSS THE RED.** King of Ulster. Husband of Maev (*q.v.*), husband of Roy, originator of the Red Branch.

**WOLFHART.** (*Vide* "Dietrich of Bern.") A follower of Dietrich of Bern (*q.v.*). He figured conspicuously in the battle of the Great Rose Garden (*q.v.*). He also took part in the unfortunate war against Ermenrich (*q.v.*).

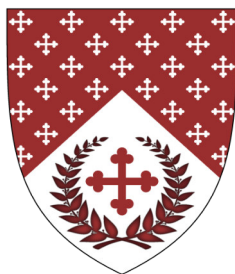

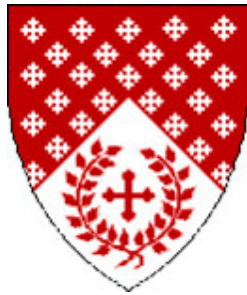
