Expenses and income continue to roll in after Saturnalia. There is rest of the site fee, and a small misc expense check and one refund that were written in early 2024. Also, the site fee for practice (\$210)is due Accounting for these, our available funds are: \$6,559.85

We have heard from the SCOREs Deputy that the corporate is "working on" the check to pay us for the folks who reserved on-line. When that is received, we should have a total of \$9,547.01

Kingdom is modifying their financial policy regarding refunds, and we need to modify ours to be compatible. See new business.


