There are outstanding un-cashed checks totaling \$2,2070.75, leaving \$9,432.27 available.

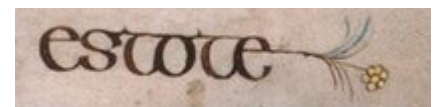
Deposit for Saturnalia has not been cashed (Ceridwen will check). Check for new feat gear has not been cashed. SCORES check has cleared.

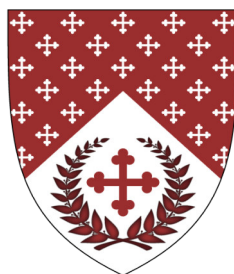

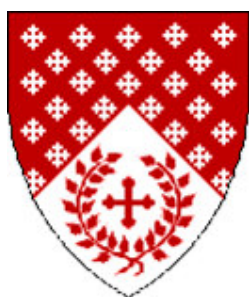
