No report. Ceridwen still not on bank account.

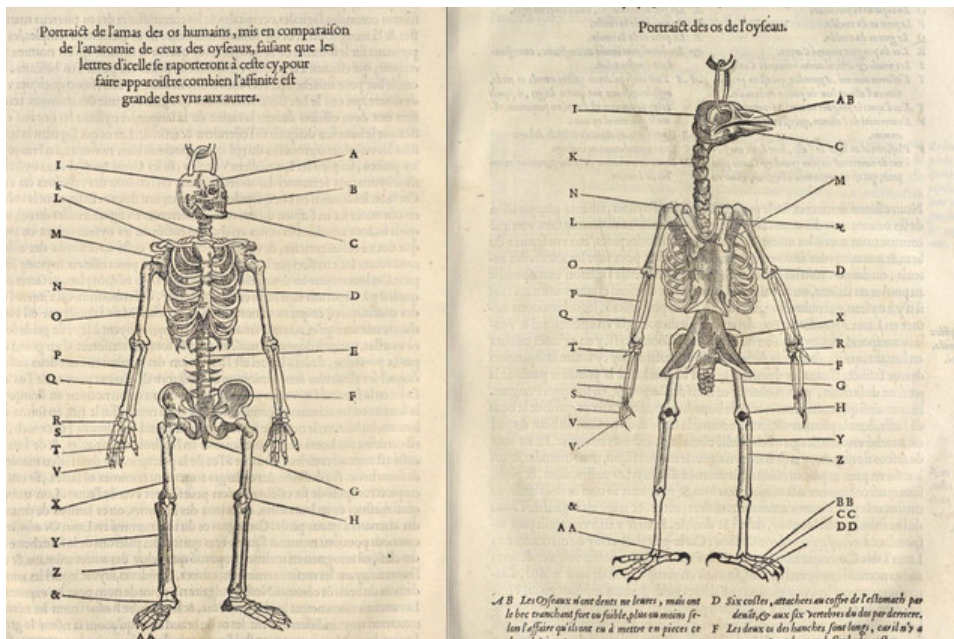

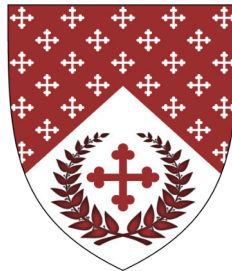

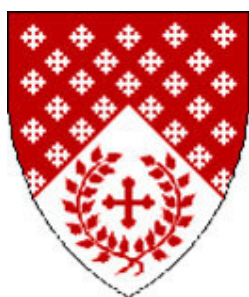
