Songbook of Zeghere van Male

Publication date 1542

This large songbook from 1542 is celebrated as much for its bizarre illuminated capitals as for its record of late medieval music. It was created for Zeghere van Male (1504-1601), a mercer and politician from Bruges (Zebrugge). The book contains 229 compositions: 15 masses (2 of them fragmentary), 64 motets, 137 secular pieces (125 French, 9 Flemish, and 3 Italian), and 12 instrumental pieces.

The manuscripts are held in the Mediathéque Municipale of Cambrai.

MS 125: tenor

MS 126: contra-tenor (i.e. alto, not the modern countertenor)

MS 127: bassus (bass)

MS 128: superius (soprano)
